AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO SUPPORT MATH, SCIENCE, CULTURE AND HISTORY EXPERIENTIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN THE STATE AND RELATED TEACHER TRAINING; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --One hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of funding the Earth shuttle New Mexico program to support scholarships for three hundred at-risk Native American, Hispanic and other middle school students to participate in the math, science, culture and history experiential education programs in the state and for related teacher training. The appropriation shall be matched by private sector contributions. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance
