AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR FAMILY DEVELOPMENT TRAINING PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for family development training programs to increase the participation of low-income parents in the education of their children. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
