AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK YOUTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION--AT-RISK YOUTH PROGRAM -- One hundred ninety-nine thousand four hundred dollars (\$199,400) is appropriated from the general fund to the substance abuse division of the department of health for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of operating and equipping a cultural development program to nurture at-risk youth with motivation and building self-esteem skills. The program shall be housed at Wells Park community center, Westside community center, West Gate community center and Los Padillas community center, all located in Bernalillo county. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
