AN ACT

RELATING TO LIBRARY SERVICES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR LIBRARY SERVICES STATEWIDE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS. --The amounts in Subsections A through C of this section are appropriated from the general fund to the library division of the office of cultural affairs for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purposes described in Subsections A through C of this section. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund. The following amounts are appropriated for the following purposes:

A. one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to provide technical assistance and training on electronic information resources for libraries statewide;

B. seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) to develop and strengthen book and document delivery systems in libraries statewide; and

C. twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to add smaller libraries in the state to participate in the statewide interlibrary loan program.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. --It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
