AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A MANAGEMENT REVIEW OF THE OFFICE OF
THE STATE ENGINEER; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --Two hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
state engineer for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for
the purpose of hiring an independent management consultant to
conduct a comprehensive management review of the
responsibilities and duties of the office of the state engineer
and to create a plan and assist in implementation of the plan to
improve the efficiency of the office and the administration of
the waters of New Mexico. Any unexpended or unencumbered
balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to
the general fund.

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A MANAGEMENT REVIEW OF THE OFFICE OF
THE STATE ENGINEER; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the state engineer for expenditure in fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of hiring an independent management consultant to conduct a comprehensive management review of the responsibilities and duties of the office of the state engineer and to create a plan and assist in implementation of the plan to improve the efficiency of the office and the administration of the waters of New Mexico. The management plan shall include the most efficient and effective way to consolidate and coordinate local, regional and statewide water study funding.

B. The state engineer shall provide to the

1 appropriate interim committees copies of the request for
2 proposal for the management review and keep the committees
3 apprised of the progress of the review.

4 C. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining
5 at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
