AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO PLAN, DESIGN AND ENGINEER A
WASTEWATER SYSTEM FOR THE SANTA TERESA BORDER STATION AND THE
AREA ALONG THE NEW MEXICO-MEXICO BORDER; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Five hundred thousand dollars
(\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
department of environment for expenditure in fiscal years 1996
and 1997 for the purpose of planning, designing and engineering
wastewater system facilities for the Santa Teresa border station
and area along the New Mexico-Mexico border. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997
shall revert to the general fund.

Section 2. EMERGENCY. -- It is necessary for the public
peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
