BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: Section 1.

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM ESTABLISHED. --

In order to alleviate a shortage of teachers certified in early childhood education, the commission on higher education shall promulgate regulations to establish a scholarship program to recruit and assist qualified individuals in obtaining certification in that subject area.

- A qualified individual shall:
- be a citizen of the United States or have a (1) permanent resident visa;
 - be a resident of the state, for tuition

- **(3)** be enrolled in either a bachelor's degree program or a certification program in early childhood education;
- have completed at least twenty-four semester hours in a post-secondary educational institution;
- **(5)** agree to work or teach in a public school in the state for at least two years; and
- have complied with regulations adopted by the commission on higher education for the scholarship program.

Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Forty-eight thousand dollars (\$48,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the commission on higher education for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 to establish a scholarship program for individuals pursuing certification in early childhood education. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.
