19	and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance
20	Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding one million five
21	hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) when the local government
22	division of the department of finance and administration
23	certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state
24	board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the
25	bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible

1 upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can 2 proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board 3 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 4 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 5 The 6 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the local government division of the department of finance and 7 administration for the purpose of acquiring land or constructing 8 9 the southwest recreation complex in Santa Fe county. Anv 10 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of 11 fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund. 12 If the local government division of the department of finance 13 and administration has not certified the need for the issuance 14 of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization 15 provided in this section shall be void.

Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
