AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF SEVERANCE TAX BONDS FOR PURCHASE OF SCHOOL BUSES FOR TESUQUE PUEBLO SCHOOL; MAKING A GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATION FOR TRANSPORTATION OPERATION EXPENSES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--PURPOSE FOR WHICH ISSUED--

APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--The state board of finance may issue and sell severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax Bonding Act in an amount not exceeding eighty-four thousand dollars (\$84,000) when the state department of public education certifies the need for the issuance of the bonds. The state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated

1 to the state department of public education for the purpose of purchasing two school buses for
2 the Tesuque Pueblo school located in Santa Fe county. Any unexpended or unencumbered
3 balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund.
4 If the state department of public education has not certified the need for the issuance of the
5 bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, the authorization provided in this section shall be void.

6 Section 2. APPROPRIATION.--Six thousand dollars (\$6,000) is appropriated from the
7 general fund to the state department of public education for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for
8 the purpose of providing maintenance support and funding insurance coverage necessary for
9 school bus transportation at the Tesuque Pueblo school in Santa Fe county. Any unexpended
10 or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general
11 fund.

13 Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that
14 this act take effect immediately.
