The state board 2 of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to 3 comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The 4 proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated to the 5 6 state engineer for the purpose of making improvements, including purchasing and installing necessary pipe and connection 7 accessories, valves, hydrants and a six inch water main, to the 8 9 La Cienega acequia in upper La Cienega located in Santa Fe 10 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the county. 11 end of fiscal year 1999 shall revert to the severance tax 12 bonding fund. If the state engineer has not certified the need 13 for the issuance of the bonds by the end of fiscal year 1998, 14 the authorization provided in this section shall be void. Section 2.
