AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A PROGRAM FOR AT-RISK YOUTH TO
CONTINUE THEIR EDUCATION AND AVOID DRUG ABUSE AND GANG ACTIVITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. -- Four hundred thousand dollars
(\$400,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
children, youth and families department for expenditure in
fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of supporting a multiple-site
program of a nonprofit organization for at-risk youth, to
encourage continued education and avoid drug abuse and gang
activity, located in a class A county with a population of more
than three hundred thousand people. Any unexpended or
unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997
shall revert to the general fund.
