17	Section 1. Section 77-2-6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1977,
18	Chapter 256, Section 3) is amended to read:
19	"77-2-6. <u>NEW MEXICO</u> LIVESTOCK BOARD ATTACHED TO NEW MEXICO
20	DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE
21	A. The <u>New Mexico livestock</u> board is attached for
22	coordinative purposes to the New Mexico department of
23	agriculture. The board shall execute a memorandum of
24	understanding with the director of the New Mexico department of
25	agriculture identifying areas for cooperation and coordination

Administrative and other services may be provided the board by the department pursuant to the terms of the memorandum of understanding. The board shall submit an annual report on its activites to the director. This section shall not be construed to affect the exercise of any board power or duty.

B. Effective July 1, 1998, the New Mexico department
of agriculture shall assume the powers, duties, assets and
obligations of the New Mexico livestock board. The secretary of
agriculture shall establish a livestock division in the
department and that division shall be responsible for oversight
of the livestock industry in New Mexico. "

Section 2. Section 77-2-28 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1981, Chapter 5, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"77-2-28. TERMINATION OF BOARD LIFE--DELAYED REPEAL.--The New Mexico livestock board is terminated [July 1, 1999] July 1, <u>1997</u> unless continued by the legislature pursuant to the Sunset Act. The board shall continue to operate according to all of the provisions of Chapter 77, Article 2 NMSA 1978 until [July 1, <del>2000</del>] July 1, 1998 for the purpose of winding up its affairs. Effective [July 1, 2000] July 1, 1998, Chapter 77, Article 2 NMSA 1978 is repealed."
