AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTION 21-1-3 NMSA 1978 (BEING LAWS 1970, CHAPTER 47, SECTION 1, AS AMENDED) TO PROVIDE FOR RESIDENT TUITION FOR NONRESIDENTS LIVING WITHIN SEVENTY-FIVE MILES OF THE NEW MEXICO BORDER IN STATES THAT RECIPROCATATE FOR NEW MEXICO STUDENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 21-1-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1970, Chapter 47, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"21-1-3. STATE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS-- RESIDENT STUDENTS. --

A. For the purpose of tuition payment at the resident student rates at state educational institutions, as defined in Article 12, Section 11 of the constitution of New Mexico, "resident student" includes:

1 (1) any person not otherwise entitled to claim
2 residence who is a member of the armed forces of the United
3 States assigned to active duty within the exterior boundaries of
4 this state; and

5 (2) the spouse or dependent child of any person
6 who qualifies under Paragraph (1) of this subsection.

7 B. Assignment to active duty within the exterior
8 boundaries of this state may be established by a certificate of
9 assignment from the commanding officer of the person so
10 assigned.

11 C. For the purpose of tuition payment at resident
12 student rates at New Mexico highlands university, "resident
13 student" may include any person who is a Native American and a
14 citizen of the United States.

15 D. "Resident student" includes any student who
16 resides within seventy-five miles of the New Mexico border in an
17 adjacent state that provides reciprocity for New Mexico
18 students. "
