A JOINT MEMORIAL

URGING STATE AGENCIES RESPONSIBLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW BLOCK GRANT SYSTEM TO PARTICIPATE IN EVERY AVAILABLE MANDATE TO MAXIMIZE FEDERAL BENEFITS TO NEW MEXICO CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, the anticipated loss of federal revenues by reductions in block grants and categorical grants will mean the loss of millions of desperately needed dollars; and

WHEREAS, these expected losses might not be as high had the state's various executive agencies participated in more of the available federal categorical programs; and

WHEREAS, prior to these cuts, the state's overall receipts of federal expenditures, compared to New Mexico revenue contributions to the federal government, have dropped from three to one to less than two to one; and

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WHEREAS, federal support, whether in the form of defenseand science-oriented jobs or social services programs, cannot be ignored by New Mexico as it seeks healthy growth for its citizens; and

WHEREAS, with a disproportionately large population living in poverty, New Mexico needs every health and human services dollar available:

NOW. THEREFORE. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the heads of all state departments and agencies that manage health, social and human services funds and services coming through federal block and categorical grants be requested to participate in every available program offered; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor and these executive agencies notify the interim legislative health and human services committee and the health care task force, at their respective October 1996 meetings, of every single option available to New Mexico with the new federal block grant system and establish opportunities to cooperate with the legislature in each option decision; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the governor and to the heads of all executive departments and agencies that manage health, social and human services programs funded by the federal government.
