A JOINT MEMORIAL
URGING STATE AGENCIES RESPONSIBLE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW
BLOCK GRANT SYSTEM TO PARTICIPATE IN EVERY AVAILABLE MANDATE TO
MAXIMIZE FEDERAL BENEFITS TO NEW MEXICO CITIZENS.

WHEREAS, the anticipated loss of federal revenues by
reductions in block grants and categorical grants will mean the
loss of millions of desperately needed dollars; and

WHEREAS, these expected losses might not be as high had the
state's various executive agencies participated in more of the
available federal categorical programs; and

WHEREAS, prior to these cuts, the state's overall receipts
of federal expenditures, compared to New Mexico revenue
contributions to the federal government, have dropped from three
to one to less than two to one; and

1 WHEREAS, federal support, whether in the form of defense-
2 and science-oriented jobs or social services programs, cannot be
3 ignored by New Mexico as it seeks healthy growth for its
4 citizens; and

5 WHEREAS, with a disproportionately large population living
6 in poverty, New Mexico needs every health and human services
7 dollar available;

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
9 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the heads of all state departments and
10 agencies that manage health, social and human services funds and
11 services coming through federal block and categorical grants be
12 requested to participate in every available program offered; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor and these
14 executive agencies notify the interim legislative health and
15 human services committee and the health care task force, at
16 their respective October 1996 meetings, of every single option
17 available to New Mexico with the new federal block grant system
18 and establish opportunities to cooperate with the legislature in
19 each option decision; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
21 transmitted to the governor and to the heads of all executive
22 departments and agencies that manage health, social and human
23 services programs funded by the federal government.
