increasing basis, New Mexico must provide for the technological
education of its children; and

WHEREAS, though traditional instructional materials are

7 Technology for Education Act funds to students attending
8 accredited private schools; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in its study the legislative
10 education study committee investigate the alternatives available
11 for distributing educational technology to all students in New
12 Mexico; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislative education study
14 committee report and publish its finding by November 1, 1996;

17 transmitted to the legislative education study committee.
