WHEREAS, American businesses have been "restructuring" by laying off millions of employees over the past few years; and

WHEREAS, many of the same companies have exported those jobs to Mexico and the Far East; and

WHEREAS, companies also force states to bid against one another by providing tax breaks and lower wages; and

WHEREAS, corporate profits have reached all-time highs while workers and employees are receiving lower wages and fewer benefits and state and local governments are receiving fewer net revenues; and

WHEREAS, the national labor caucus of state legislators has

proposed a multistate industrial retention commission to investigate plant closings and mass layoffs and to recommend economic sanctions such as public sector purchasing sanctions and public employee pension fund divestment against businesses that export jobs and promote interstate job competition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the work force development board, with the cooperation of the labor department, be requested to investigate alternative methods, including joining a multistate industrial retention commission, to discourage the exportation of jobs and unfair interstate job competition; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the work force development board and the labor department.
