A JOINT MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION IN THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS THROUGHOUT THE STATE AND TO DEVELOP CRITERIA FOR A STATEWIDE CURRICULUM

WHEREAS, more than fifty schools at all grade levels have some form of environmental education through conventional biology, geography, general science, English, history, math or social studies; and

WHEREAS, several state agencies have cooperated with public school systems to provide assistance for environmental education classes, including the state land office, the office of cultural affairs, the department of environment, the energy, minerals and
