A JOINT RESOLUTION

APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE TRANSFER OF REAL PROPERTY BY THE
GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT TO THE STATE ARMORY BOARD.

WHEREAS, the property control division of the general
services department has control over certain state buildings and
lands; and

WHEREAS, the property control division of the general
services department has authority to sell or trade state
buildings and real property under its control in accordance with
Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978; and

WHEREAS, the property of approximately seven and one-half
acres in the city of Santa Fe known as 1050 Old Pecos trail is
under the jurisdiction of the property control division of the
general services department; and

WHEREAS, that property is the former New Mexico national

1 guard headquarters and training center; and

2 WHEREAS, after construction of a new national guard armory
3 on Cerrillos road in the city of Santa Fe, the state armory
4 board transferred title to the property to the general services
5 department; and

6 WHEREAS, the New Mexico national guard 200th coast
7 artillery regiment trained at the former national guard armory
8 site on Old Pecos trail; and

9 WHEREAS, the 200th coast artillery regiment was the primary
10 military unit in the "Bataan death march"; and

11 WHEREAS, less than half of the one thousand eight hundred
12 New Mexicans deployed to the Philippines in 1942 returned from
13 the "Bataan death march"; and

14 WHEREAS, the New Mexico house of representatives passed
15 House Memorial 76 in 1994 supporting the relocation of the
16 Bataan memorial military museum to that site; and

17 WHEREAS, the Bataan memorial military museum was relocated
18 to the lobby of the theater at 1050 Old Pecos trail in August
19 1994; and

20 WHEREAS, there is significant interest by the national
21 association of American prisoners of war and others to locate a
22 world-class national Bataan memorial museum at the site of the
23 former New Mexico national guard headquarters and training
24 center on Old Pecos trail; and

25 WHEREAS, the Bataan memorial military museum and the New

1 Mexico national guard historical foundation have requested that
2 the general services department return the property to the state
3 armory board; and

4 WHEREAS, the armory for the arts theater, the children's
5 museum and the center for contemporary arts occupy facilities at
6 1050 Old Pecos trail; and

7 WHEREAS, the Bataan memorial military museum and the New
8 Mexico national guard historical foundation have expressed
9 interest in continuing the current activities of the armory for
10 the arts theater, the children's museum and the center for
11 contemporary arts located on the property until plans for a
12 national museum are further developed and until appropriate
13 space can be found to relocate those functions; and

14 WHEREAS, the value of the property exceeds one hundred
15 thousand dollars (\$100,000);

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE
17 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the general services department be
18 authorized to transfer to the state armory board the real
19 property and improvements located at 1050 Old Pecos trail in
20 Santa Fe; and

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of general
22 services be empowered to take all actions necessary or expedient
23 to accomplish the transfer of the real property to the state
24 armory board; and

25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any leases or other written

1 agreements between the general services department and other
2 entities at 1050 Old Pecos trail will transfer to and be binding
3 upon the state armory board; and

4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, pursuant to Section 13-6-3
5 NMSA 1978, the legislature approve and ratify the transfer of
6 the real property described herein by the general services
7 department to the state armory board; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be
9 transmitted to the general services department, the state armory
10 board and the Bataan memorial military museum.
