A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 9, SECTION 10 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO AUTHORIZE COUNTY GOVERNMENTS TO BORROW MONEY FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION AND REPAIR.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 9, Section 10 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"No county shall borrow money except for the following purposes:

- A. erecting, remodeling and making additions to necessary public buildings;
- B. constructing or repairing public roads and bridges and purchasing equipment for such projects;
- C. constructing or acquiring a system for supplying

1 water, including the acquisition of water and water rights,
2 necessary real estate or rights-of-way and easements;

3 D. constructing or acquiring a sewer system,
4 including the necessary real estate or rights-of-way and
5 easements;

6 E. constructing an airport or sanitary landfill,
7 including the necessary real estate; or

8 F. the purchase of books and other library resources
9 for libraries in the county.

10 In such cases, indebtedness shall be incurred only after
11 the proposition to create such debt has been submitted to the
12 registered voters of the county and approved by a majority of
13 those voting thereon. No bonds issued for such purpose shall
14 run for more than fifty years. Provided, however, that no money
15 derived from general obligation bonds issued and sold hereunder
16 shall be used for maintaining existing buildings and, if so,
17 such bonds shall be invalid. "

18 Section 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall
19 be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection at
20 the next general election or at any special election prior to
21 that date which may be called for that purpose.
