AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS;  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT-- APPROPRIATIONS. --

A. Seven hundred eighty-seven thousand dollars (\$787,000) is appropriated from the subsequent injury fund to the general services department for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 to renovate and make improvements to existing facilities at camp Sierra Blanca for use as a work camp for juvenile offenders.

B. Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) is appropriated from the subsequent injury fund to the general services department for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 to

1 design, construct and equip a special adjustment unit at the  
2 youth diagnostic and development center in Albuquerque.

3 C. Four hundred thirty-four thousand four hundred  
4 dollars (\$434,400) is appropriated from the subsequent injury  
5 fund to the general services department for expenditure in  
6 fiscal years 1996 and 1997 for the purpose of completing  
7 construction of and equipping a new ~~minimum~~-security facility at  
8 southern New Mexico correctional facility in Dona Ana county.

9 D. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
10 at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

11 Section 2. CHILDREN YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT--  
12 APPROPRIATION.--Five hundred thirty-two thousand dollars  
13 (\$532,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the  
14 children, youth and families department for expenditure in  
15 fiscal year 1997 for repairs to and maintenance of the youth  
16 diagnostic and development center in Albuquerque. Any  
17 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
18 fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

19 Section 3. PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND--  
20 APPROPRIATION.--Two million dollars (\$2,000,000) is appropriated  
21 from the subsequent injury fund to the public school capital  
22 outlay fund for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose  
23 of meeting critical school district capital outlay needs. This  
24 appropriation is contingent upon the Rio Rancho school district  
25 being permitted to submit an application for grant assistance

1 from the public school capital outlay fund for the 1996-1997  
2 school year. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining  
3 at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the general fund.

4 Section 4. OFFICE OF THE STATE ENGINEER-- APPROPRIATION. --

5 Four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) is appropriated from  
6 the general fund to the office of the state engineer for  
7 expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the purpose of making  
8 repairs to Ute dam. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
9 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the  
10 general fund.

11 Section 5. REGIONAL JUVENILE SERVICES GRANT FUND--

12 APPROPRIATION. --Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) is  
13 appropriated from the general fund to the regional juvenile  
14 services grant fund for expenditure in fiscal year 1997 for the  
15 purpose making grants for construction of regional multipurpose  
16 facilities for juvenile offenders pursuant to the Regional  
17 Juvenile Services Act. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance  
18 remaining at the end of fiscal year 1997 shall revert to the  
19 general fund.

20 Section 6. STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT--

21 APPROPRIATION. --Five million dollars (\$5,000,000) is  
22 appropriated from the state road fund to the state highway and  
23 transportation department for expenditure in fiscal year 1997  
24 for the purpose of making improvements to roads on Indian lands.  
25 Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of

1 fiscal year 1997 shall not revert to the state road fund.

2 Section 7. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
3 peace, health and safety that the provisions of this act take  
4 effect immediately.
