department as a branch of the state's government in Santa Fe" through activities that included: "the securing for New Mexico of an adequately financed and efficiently managed state department of health" by educating the legislature and the public about the importance of public health programs; and

WHEREAS, these goals of the New Mexico public health association were accomplished within two years with the establishment of a department of health in 1919; and

WHEREAS, population-based public health programs in New Mexico have a distinguished record in reducing infectious and communicable diseases, dramatically lowering infant mortality, rapidly responding to newly emerging health problems, data collection and vital statistics and tremendously increasing access to health services; and

WHEREAS, the New Mexico public health association has maintained its advocacy of protection, promotion and prevention activities for all citizens of New Mexico for these eighty years; and

WHEREAS, the essential nature of public health and population-based public health programs remains critically important to the citizens of New Mexico today and on into the future:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF

REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that it commemorate and commend the New Mexico public health association for eighty years of service to the citizens of New Mexico; and
