20	WHEREAS, these two teachers were also reprimanded for
21	teaching units on racial and religious tolerance; and
22	WHEREAS, the superintendent of Vaughn municipal schools
23	intends to recommend to the Vaughn school board that they be
24	fired for insubordination; and
25	WHEREAS, Patsy and Nadine Cordova are lifelong residents of

Vaughn, New Mexico and long-time teachers from that community;
and

WHEREAS, Chicano studies teach about the history, the culture and the five hundred-year struggle of a people's quest for equality and justice;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the Vaughn municipal school district be requested to reinstate, with back pay, the suspended teachers and that Chicano studies curricula be made available in all schools of the state and that teachers be encouraged to teach these curricula so that all students may be able to gain knowledge of this ethnic group; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be transmitted to the Vaughn school board and the state board of education.
