WHEREAS, if one's professional importance is judged by the type of certificate, license or registration one receives, teachers must rank at the bottom, which is not a very good message to send to people who are so important to the lives of our families and the futures of our children;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state department of public education be requested to redesign teacher's certificates to more properly convey the stature of the job and send the message that teachers are as important as the other professionals licensed in this state; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this memorial be transmitted to the state department of public education.
