WHEREAS, the Charter Schools Act has allowed a limited number of individual public schools in New Mexico to become charter schools and initiate innovative changes in teaching methods and budgeting; and

WHEREAS, the flexibility allowed by the Charter Schools Act is available to only a few schools due to limits in the current law; and

WHEREAS, there are many schools and local school districts that could utilize the flexibility allowed by the Charter School Act to modify the organization and operation of their schools to meet the unique needs of their student population and respond to the challenges and opportunities
