A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 11, SECTION 1 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE FOR APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC REGULATION COMMISSION MEMBERS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. It is proposed to amend Article 11, Section 1 of the constitution of New Mexico to read:

"The "public regulation commission" is created. The commission shall consist of five members [ ~~elected from districts provided by law~~] appointed for staggered four-year terms [ ~~beginning on January 1 of the year following their election; provided that those chosen at the first~~]. Members elected at the 1998 general election [ ~~after the adoption of this section~~] shall immediately classify themselves by lot, so that two of them shall hold office for two years and three of
