A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING A LONG-TERM LEASE OF THE PENITENTIARY OF NEW MEXICO'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT TO SANTA FE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978 requires ratification and approval of any sale, trade or lease of state property over one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in value; and

WHEREAS, the property control division of the general services department is desirous of leasing the penitentiary of New Mexico's wastewater treatment plant to Santa Fe county for a period not to exceed ninety-nine years; and

WHEREAS, the lease is contingent on Santa Fe county providing free wastewater treatment services to state agencies, including the penitentiary and other state buildings occupied at present by the corrections department and the department of military affairs; and

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1 WHEREAS, the real property, with improvements, is more 2 particularly described as follows: A certain tract of land within Santa Fe 3 County, New Mexico, being a portion of the South 4 half of Section 34, T. 16N., R. 8E., N. M. P. M., and being more particularly described by metes and 7 bounds as follows: 8 BEGINNING at the Southwesterly corner of the 9 tract marked by a U.S.G.L.O. stone monument marking the Section Corner common to Sections 33 and 34, 10 11 T. 16 N., R. 8E. and Sections 3 and 4, T. 15 N., R. 8 12 E.; thence,

NOO°10'51"E, 2089.28 feet to a calculated point on the I-25 frontage road right-of-way; thence, along said right-of-way,

N51°17'58"E, 884.09 feet to a Koogle and Pouls capped rebar, Surveyor #4076; thence, leaving said right-of-way,

 $N89^{\circ}38'04''E$, 1947.08 feet to a 3" pipe, being the center of Section 34; thence,

N89°37′10″E, 2582.44 feet to a U.S.G.L.O. ¼ corner stone on the East boundary of section 34; thence

S00°03'37"W, 2662.11 feet to a calculated point for the section corner common to

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Sections 2 and 3, T. 15 N., R. 8 E., and section 34 and 35 T. 16 N., R. 8 E.; thence S89° 52' 28"W, 2579. 99 feet to a U. S. G. L. 0.

4 corner stone; thence,

 $S89^{\circ}54'59''W$, 2643.20 feet to the point and place of beginning.

Containing 313.275 acres, more or less.

All as shown on that certain plat of survey titled "State of New Mexico, State Armory Board, New Mexico National Guard Armory, within Section 34, T. 16 N., R. 8E., N. M. P. M., Santa Fe County, New Mexico", dated June, 1987 by Richard E. Smith, NMPLS #5837, as filed for record on June 30, 1987 in the office of the Santa Fe County Clerk in Book 175 at Page 001, as Reception #626,050.

Provided, however, that the State of New Mexico shall retain a right-of-way easement along former State Road NMSHD R/W Project No. SP 2536 (800), consisting of 13.877± acres, as shown on the above-referenced plat.

Subject to reservations, restrictions, and/or easements of record.;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the proposed lease be hereby ratified and approved pursuant to the provisions of Section 13-6-3 NMSA

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1978; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the property control division of the general services department.
