A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING TO TRANSFER ALL OF THE PROPERTY KNOWN AS LOS LUNAS MEDICAL CENTER TO THE LOS LUNAS SCHOOL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Section 13-6-3 NMSA 1978 requires ratification and approval of any sale of state-owned real property for consideration of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) or more; and

WHEREAS, the property control division of the general services department is desirous of ensuring the maintenance and use of the property known as Los Lunas medical center, more particularly described as:

A certain tract of land within the San Clemente
Land Grant in Valencia County, New Mexico. This
tract comprises Tracts 60, 107-b, and 108, as shown
on Map 69 of the surveys of the Middle Rio Grande

WHEREAS, the Los Lunas school district desires to maintain and use the Los Lunas medical center and will develop a plan to maximize the use of that property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the property control division of the general services department be authorized to enter into negotiations with the Los Lunas school district to determine a transfer price of the Los Lunas medical center, such price not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after all conditions of the negotiations between the property control division of the general services department and the Los Lunas school district have been met, the Los Lunas medical center shall be transferred to the Los Lunas school district in fee simple and in perpetuity; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be transmitted to the property control division of the general services department, the department of health and the Los
