15 exist, which agencies are responsible for which services,  
16 existing gaps in those services, additional preventive and  
17 early intervention services needed by communities and any  
18 other problems related to the families in need of services  
19 program; and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department of health, the  
21 state department of public education, the administrative  
22 office of the courts and the human services department  
23 participate in the effort as members of the panel and by  
24 providing all statistics needed to accomplish the purposes of  
25 this memorial; and
