A new section of the Health Care Purchasing 20 Act is enacted to read: 21 "[NEW MATERIAL] ARTERY CALCIFICATION SCREENING COVERAGE .--22 Α. Group health coverage, including any form of 23 self-insurance, offered, issued or renewed under the Health Care Purchasing Act shall provide coverage for eligible 24 25 enrollees to receive artery calcification screening. .204678.1

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1 Coverage provided pursuant to this section Β. 2 shall: be limited to the provision of an artery 3 (1) calcification screening to an eligible enrollee once every five 4 5 years; and not be subject to a deductible. 6 (2) 7 C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to short-term travel, accident-only or limited or specified-8 9 disease policies, plans or certificates of health insurance. D. As used in this section: 10 "artery calcification screening" means a (1)11 12 computed tomography scan measuring coronary artery calcification for atheroscleroris and abnormal artery structure 13 14 and function; and "eligible enrollee" means an enrollee: (2) 15 (a) who is: 1) a male older than thirty 16 years of age and younger than seventy-six years of age; or 2) 17 a female older than forty years of age and younger than 18 seventy-six years of age; and 19 20 (b) who has a risk of developing coronary heart disease based on at least one of the following: 21 hypertension, hyperlipidemia, diabetes, smoking or family 22 history of heart disease." 23 SECTION 2. 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1 "[NEW MATERIAL] ARTERY CALCIFICATION SCREENING COVERAGE .--2 Α. By January 1, 2018 and in accordance with federal law, the secretary shall adopt and promulgate rules 3 that provide medicaid coverage for eligible recipients to 4 receive artery calcification screening. 5 Β. Medicaid coverage provided pursuant to this 6 7 section shall be limited to the provision of an artery calcification screening to an eligible recipient once every 8 9 five years. C. As used in this section: 10 "artery calcification screening" means a (1)11 12 computed tomography scan measuring coronary artery calcification for atheroscleroris and abnormal artery structure 13 14 and function; and "eligible recipient" means a recipient: (2) 15 (a) who is: 1) a male older than thirty 16 years of age and younger than seventy-six years of age; or 2) 17 a female older than forty years of age and younger than 18 seventy-six years of age; and 19 20 (b) who has a risk of developing coronary heart disease based on at least one of the following: 21 hypertension, hyperlipidemia, diabetes, smoking or family 22 history of heart disease." 23 SECTION 3. A new section of Chapter 59A, Article 22 NMSA 24 25 1978 is enacted to read: .204678.1 - 3 -

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1 "[NEW MATERIAL] ARTERY CALCIFICATION SCREENING COVERAGE .--2 An individual or group health insurance policy, Α. health care plan and certificate of health insurance delivered 3 or issued for delivery in this state shall provide coverage for 4 eligible insureds to receive artery calcification screening. 5 Coverage provided pursuant to this section 6 Β. 7 shall: be limited to the provision of an artery 8 (1)9 calcification screening to an eligible insured once every five 10 years; and (2) not be subject to a deductible. 11 12 C. The provisions of this section do not apply to short-term travel, accident-only or limited or specified-13 disease policies, plans or certificates of health insurance. 14 D. A new section of Chapter 59A, Article 23 NMSA 4 5 1978 is enacted to read: "[NEW MATERIAL] ARTERY CALCIFICATION SCREENING COVERAGE .--6 7 A group or blanket health insurance policy, Α. health care plan or certificate of health insurance that is 8 9 delivered, issued for delivery or renewed in this state shall 10 provide coverage for eligible insureds to receive artery calcification screening. 11 12 Β. Coverage provided pursuant to this section 13 shall: 14 (1)be limited to the provision of an artery calcification screening to an eligible insured once every five 15 years; and 16 17 (2) not be subject to a deductible. C. The provisions of this section do not apply to 18 19 short-term travel, accident-only or limited or specified-20 disease policies, plans or certificates of health insurance. As used in this section: D. 21 "artery calcification screening" means a 22 (1)computed tomography scan measuring coronary artery 23 calcification for atheroscleroris and abnormal artery structure 24 25 and function; and .204678.1 - 5 -

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1 "eligible insured" means an insured: (2) 2 (a) who is: 1) a male older than thirty years of age and younger than seventy-six years of age; or 2) 3 a female older than forty years of age and younger than 4 seventy-six years of age; and 5 (b) who has a risk of developing 6 7 coronary heart disease based on at least one of the following: hypertension, hyperlipidemia, diabetes, smoking or family 8 history of heart disease." 9 SECTION 5. A new section of the Health Maintenance 10 Organization Law is enacted to read: 11 12 "[NEW MATERIAL] ARTERY CALCIFICATION SCREENING COVERAGE .--An individual or group health maintenance 13 Α. 14 organization contract that is delivered, issued for delivery or renewed in this state shall provide coverage for eligible 15 enrollees to receive artery calcification screening. 16 17 Β. Coverage provided pursuant to this section shall: 18 19 (1)be limited to the provision of an artery 20 calcification screening to an eligible enrollee once every five years; and 21 (2) not be subject to a deductible. 22 С.
