AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO EXPAND ACCESS AND ENROLLMENT IN ADULT LITERACY PROGRAMS STATEWIDE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.--Ten million dollars
