APPROPRIATION.--Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the SEC→~~board of regents of New Mexico state university~~←SEC SEC→public education department←SEC for expenditure in fiscal years 2026 and 2027 for the SEC→~~Torrance county farm and livestock bureau to develop~~←SEC SEC→Estancia municipal school district and Mountainair public school district to develop and implement←SEC curriculum for a high school New Mexico history course, to be offered locally, that is focused on the settlement of the lower Estancia valley from pre-Columbian times through the modern era. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2027 shall revert to the general fund.
