AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY TO ASSESS THE POTENTIAL ACQUISITION BY THE STATE OF THE STAR AXIS SCULPTURAL OBSERVATORY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. --

A. Two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the board of regents of New Mexico highlands university for expenditure in fiscal years 2025 through 2027 to conduct a feasibility study to assess the potential acquisition by the state of Star Axis, a privately owned sculptural observatory located in San Miguel county, including:

(1) assessing the cost of legally necessary upgrades required for public access;
