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18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	SECTION 1. Section 50-7-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1957,
20	Chapter 219, Section 4) is amended to read:
21	"50-7-4. DUTIES OF THE COUNCIL
22	<u>A.</u> The council shall formulate standards to
23	safeguard the welfare of apprentices, giving consideration to
24	standards advocated by the [bureau] <u>office</u> of apprenticeship <u>of</u>

1	department of labor; [and] <u>provided that in no case shall the</u>
2	ratio of apprentice to journeyman exceed one-to-one for trade
3	program standards registered in the building and construction
4	industry trades. The council shall formulate such additional
5	policies as may be necessary to carry out the intent and
6	purposes of [the act] Sections 50-7-1 through 50-7-7 NMSA 1978.
7	The council shall prescribe its own rules of procedure.
8	B. For trade classifications requiring journeyman
9	certification, each apprentice shall be supervised on a one-to-
10	<u>one basis by an individual who:</u>
11	(1) has obtained a journeyman certificate of
12	competence in the journeyman classification that the individual
13	will be supervising; and
14	(2) is recognized by the construction
15	industries division of the regulation and licensing department
16	as properly certified to engage in the journeyman
17	classification that the individual will be supervising."
18	SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the
19	provisions of this act is July 1, 2025.
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
