18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
19	SECTION 1. A new section of Chapter 24 NMSA 1978 is
20	enacted to read:
21	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] ESTABLISHMENT OF THE NEW MEXICO RESIDENT
22	PHYSICIAN RECRUITMENT PROGRAM
23	A. The "New Mexico resident physician recruitment
24	program" is established within the graduate medical education
25	office at the university of New Mexico.

1	B. The graduate medical education office shall
2	administer the program and allocate funding for:
3	(1) up to two weeks per year of supervised
4	rotations at non-university of New Mexico hospitals and clinics
5	in the state for participating resident physicians; and
6	(2) resident salaries, cost-of-living
7	stipends, medical malpractice insurance and travel
8	reimbursement.
9	C. Hospitals and clinics participating in the
10	program shall:
11	(1) provide an adequate learning environment
12	for resident physicians;
13	(2) designate a licensed physician mentor to
14	oversee a resident's clinical activities; and
15	(3) adhere to all applicable resident work
16	hour restrictions as required by the national accreditation
17	body for graduate medical education.
18	D. The graduate medical education office shall, no
19	later than January 1, 2026, annually survey participating
20	hospitals, clinics and residents to assess program outcomes and
21	provide a report to the legislature."
22	SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION One million two hundred
23	thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) is appropriated from the general
24	fund to the board of regents of the university of New Mexico
25	for expenditure in fiscal year 2026 for funding additional
