 - 5. On page 29, line 23, strike "and".
- 6. On page 29, line 25, strike the period and closing quotation mark and insert in lieu thereof "; and".
 - 7. On page 29, after line 25, insert:
- "(4) a discharge composed entirely of return flows from irrigation.".
