AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYMENT; PROVIDING THAT THE CRIMINAL OFFENDER
EMPLOYMENT ACT DOES NOT APPLY TO CERTAIN AGENCIES; REQUIRING
EXEMPT AGENCIES TO PROMULGATE RULES RELATED TO CRIMINAL HISTORY
SCREENING; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. Section 28-2-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1974, Chapter 78, Section 5) is amended to read:

"28-2-5. NONAPPLICABILITY TO [LAW ENFORCEMENT]

AGENCIES.--

 $\underline{A.}$  The Criminal Offender Employment Act is not applicable to:

(1) any law enforcement agency [however];

(2) the early childhood education and care department for consideration of an applicant for licensure, .228883.4SA

1	registration or employment at a child care facility;
2	(3) an agency for consideration of an
3	applicant for employment as a caregiver or hospital caregiver
4	subject to the Caregivers Criminal History Screening Act;
5	(4) the children, youth and families
6	department; and
7	(5) the public education department for
8	consideration of an applicant for licensure under the School
9	Personnel Act.
10	B. Nothing [herein] in the Criminal Offender
11	Employment Act shall be construed to preclude [a law
12	enforcement] an exempt agency in its discretion from adopting
13	the policy set forth [ <del>herein</del> ] <u>in that act.</u>
14	C. An agency exempted pursuant to Subsection A of
15	this section shall promulgate rules related to criminal history
16	screening for the purpose of determining eligibility."
17	SECTION 2. EMERGENCYIt is necessary for the public
18	peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
