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17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. Section 10-11-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1987,
19	Chapter 253, Section 2, as amended) is amended to read:
20	"10-11-2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Public Employees
21	Retirement Act:
22	A. "accumulated member contributions" means the
23	amounts deducted from the salary of a member and credited to
24	the member's individual account, together with interest, if
25	any, credited to that account;
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1 Β. "affiliated public employer" means the state and 2 any public employer affiliated with the association as provided 3 in the Public Employees Retirement Act, but does not include an 4 employer pursuant to the Magistrate Retirement Act, the 5 Judicial Retirement Act or the Educational Retirement Act; "association" means the public employees 6 C. 7 retirement association established under the Public Employees 8 Retirement Act; 9 D. "coverage plan funded ratio" means the ratio of 10 the actuarial value of the assets of a coverage plan to the 11 actuarial accrued liability of the association for payments 12 from the coverage plan, as determined by the association's 13 actuaries: 14 Ε. "disability retired member" means a retired 15 member who is receiving a pension pursuant to the disability 16 retirement provisions of the Public Employees Retirement Act; 17 "disability retirement pension" means the F. 18 pension paid pursuant to the disability retirement provisions 19 of the Public Employees Retirement Act; 20 "educational retirement system" means that G. 21 retirement system provided for in the Educational Retirement 22 Act; 23 н. "employee" means any employee of an affiliated 24 public employer; 25 "federal social security program" means that I. .228867.1

J. "final average salary" means the final average
salary calculated in accordance with the provisions of the
applicable coverage plan;

K. "form of payment" means the applicable form of payment of a pension provided for in Section 10-11-117 NMSA 1978;

10 L. "former member" means a person who was 11 previously employed by an affiliated public employer, who has 12 terminated that employment and who has received a refund of 13 member contributions;

14 M. "fund" means the funds included under the Public15 Employees Retirement Act;

N. "member" means a currently employed, contributing employee of an affiliated public employer, or a person who has been but is not currently employed by an affiliated public employer, who has not retired and who has not received a refund of member contributions; "member" also includes the following:

(1) "adult correctional officer member" means a member who is employed as an adult correctional officer or an adult correctional officer specialist by a state correctional facility of the corrections department or its successor agency; .228867.1

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1 (2) "adult probation and parole officer 2 member" means a member who is employed as a probation and 3 parole officer by the corrections department or its successor 4 agency; 5 (3) "juvenile correctional officer member"

6 means a member who is employed as a juvenile correctional 7 officer by the children, youth and families department or its 8 successor agency;

9 (4) "juvenile probation and parole officer
10 member" means a member who is employed as a probation and
11 parole officer by the children, youth and families department
12 or its successor agency;

(5) "municipal detention officer member" means a member who is employed by an affiliated public employer other than the state and who has inmate custodial responsibilities at a facility used for the confinement of persons charged with or convicted of a violation of a law or ordinance;

(6) "municipal fire member" means any member who is employed as a full-time nonvolunteer firefighter by an affiliated public employer, other than the state, and who has taken the oath prescribed for firefighters;

(7) "municipal police member" means any member
who is employed as a:

(a) police officer by an affiliated public employer, other than the state, and who has taken the .228867.1

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1 oath prescribed for police officers; or 2 (b) public safety telecommunicator by an 3 affiliated public employer, other than the state; 4 "state fire member" means any member who (8) 5 is employed as a nonvolunteer firefighter of the state and who has taken the oath prescribed for firefighters; and 6 7 "state police member" means a member who (9) 8 is: 9 (a) an officer of the New Mexico state 10 police division and who has taken the oath prescribed for such 11 officers and shall include a member who is an officer of the 12 New Mexico state police division and who was certified and 13 commissioned in the former motor transportation division or the 14 former special investigations division of the department of 15 public safety; or 16 (b) a public safety telecommunicator 17 employed by the state; 18 0. "membership" means membership in the 19 association: 20 Ρ. "pension" means a series of monthly payments to 21 a retired member or survivor beneficiary as provided in the 22 Public Employees Retirement Act; 23 "public employer" means the state, any Q. 24 municipality, city, county, metropolitan arroyo flood control 25 authority, economic development district, regional housing .228867.1 - 5 -

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1 authority, soil and water conservation district, entity created 2 pursuant to a joint powers agreement, council of government, 3 conservancy district, irrigation district, water and sanitation 4 district, water district and metropolitan water board, 5 including the boards, departments, bureaus and agencies of a 6 public employer, so long as these entities fall within the 7 meaning of governmental plan as that term is used in Section 8 414(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended;

R. "refund beneficiary" means a supplemental needs trust or a natural person designated by the member, in writing, in the form prescribed by the association, as the trust or person that would be refunded the member's accumulated member contributions payable if the member dies and no survivor pension is payable or that would receive the difference between pension paid and accumulated member contributions if the retired member dies before receiving in pension payments the amount of the accumulated member contributions;

S. "retire" means to:

(1) terminate employment with all employers covered by any state system or the educational retirement system; and

(2) receive a pension from a state system or the educational retirement system;

T. "retired member" means a person who has met all requirements for retirement and who is receiving a pension from .228867.1 - 6 -

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the fund;

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U. "retirement board" means the retirement board provided for in the Public Employees Retirement Act;

4 "salary" means the base salary or wages paid a V. 5 member, including longevity pay, for personal services rendered an affiliated public employer. "Salary" shall not include 6 7 overtime pay, unless the overtime payment is required for a 8 regular scheduled tour of duty as set forth in Section 207(k) 9 of Title 29 of the United States Code and is made on the 10 regular payroll for the period represented by that payment, 11 allowances for housing, clothing, equipment or travel, payments 12 for unused sick leave, unless the unused sick leave payment is 13 made through continuation of the member on the regular payroll 14 for the period represented by that payment, and any other form 15 of remuneration not specifically designated by law as included 16 in salary for Public Employees Retirement Act purposes. Salary 17 in excess of the limitations set forth in Section 401(a)(17) of 18 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, shall be 19 disregarded. The limitation on compensation for eligible 20 employees shall not be less than the amount that was allowed to 21 be taken into account under the state retirement system acts in 22 effect on July 1, 1993. For purposes of this subsection, 23 "eligible employee" means an individual who was a member of a 24 state system before the first plan year beginning after 25 December 31, 1995;

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W. "state system" means the retirement programs provided for in the Public Employees Retirement Act, the Magistrate Retirement Act and the Judicial Retirement Act;

"state retirement system acts" means Χ. collectively the Public Employees Retirement Act, the Magistrate Retirement Act, the Judicial Retirement Act and the 7 Volunteer Firefighters Retirement Act;

"supplemental needs trust" means a valid third-Υ. party irrevocable trust that is authorized by the federal Social Security Act, as amended, for the sole benefit and lifetime of a trust beneficiary who is disabled and is created for the purpose of providing, accounting for or receiving supplemental assets that do not supplant, impair or diminish any benefits or assistance of any federal, state or other government entity for which the beneficiary would otherwise be eligible; and

z. "survivor beneficiary" means a supplemental needs trust or a natural person that receives a pension or that has been designated to be paid a pension as a result of the death of a member or retired member."

SECTION 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION--MUNICIPAL POLICE MEMBER COVERAGE PLAN 5--PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS--ELECTION.--On or before December 30, 2025, the retirement board provided for in the Public Employees Retirement Act shall conduct an election to submit to municipal police members currently .228867.1

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contributing under a municipal general member coverage plan the question of adopting municipal police member coverage plan 5. The election shall be conducted in accordance with procedures adopted by the retirement board, and the retirement board shall certify the results of the election to the secretary of state on or before January 1, 2026.

7 SECTION 3. TEMPORARY PROVISION--STATE PUBLIC SAFETY 8 MEMBER COVERAGE PLAN 1--PUBLIC SAFETY TELECOMMUNICATORS--9 ELECTION.--On or before December 30, 2025, the retirement board 10 provided for in the Public Employees Retirement Act shall 11 conduct an election to submit to state police members currently 12 contributing under state general member coverage plan 3 the 13 question of adopting state public safety member coverage plan 14 The election shall be conducted in accordance with 1. 15 procedures adopted by the retirement board, and the retirement 16 board shall certify the results of the election to the 17 secretary of state on or before January 1, 2026.

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
