14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	SECTION 1. Section 66-7-301 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
16	Chapter 35, Section 405, as amended) is amended to read:
17	"66-7-301. SPEED REGULATION
18	A. No person shall drive a vehicle on a highway at
19	a speed greater than:
20	(1) fifteen miles per hour on all highways
21	when passing a school while children are going to or leaving
22	school and when the school zone is properly posted;
23	(2) thirty miles per hour in a business or
24	residence district;
25	(3) fifty-five miles per hour on a county

1 road, as defined in Section 66-7-304 NMSA 1978, without a 2 posted speed limit; 3 seventy-five miles per hour; and (4) the posted speed limit in construction 4 (5) 5 zones posted as double fine zones or other safety zones posted as double fine zones as designated by the department of 6 7 transportation; provided that the posted speed limit shall be 8 determined by an engineering study performed by the department 9 of transportation. 10 In every event, speed shall be so controlled by Β. 11 the driver as may be necessary: 12 to avoid colliding with a person, vehicle (1)13 or other conveyance on or entering the highway; 14 to comply with legal requirements as may (2)15 be established by the department of transportation or the New 16 Mexico state police division of the department of public safety 17 and the duty of all persons to use due care; and 18 (3) to protect workers in construction zones 19 posted as double fine zones or other safety zones posted as 20 double fine zones as designated by the department of 21 transportation. 22 C. No person shall drive a truck tractor on a 23 highway at a speed greater than sixty-five miles per hour. 24 [G.] D. The speed limits set forth in Subsection A 25 of this section may be altered as authorized in Section .230104.1

Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). 2 3 Upon a second conviction for transport of a F. 4 reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight 5 pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more 6 than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with 7 Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars 8 (\$500).
