19	SECTION 1. [ <u>NEW MATERIAL</u> ] LOCAL GOVERNMENT BORDER SUPPORT
20	REIMBURSEMENT FUNDCREATEDPURPOSERULEMAKING
21	A. As used in this section, "fund" means the local
22	government border support reimbursement fund.
23	B. The "local government border support
24	reimbursement fund" is created as a nonreverting fund in the
25	state treasury. The fund consists of appropriations, gifts,

Disbursements from the fund shall 6 be made by warrant of the secretary of finance and 7 administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the secretary of 8 finance and administration or the secretary's authorized 9 representative.

10 C. The department of finance and administration 11 shall promulgate rules to administer the fund. Money in the 12 fund shall be used to provide reimbursement to local 13 governments for the following border-related expenses incurred 14 as a direct result of requests from the state and federal 15 government:

16 (1) emergency medical services provided to
17 individuals in medical crisis;

(2) law enforcement response to unattendeddeaths; and

(3) costs associated with:

 (a) specialized equipment necessary to support border patrol, including all-terrain vehicles and trailers;
