10	A JOINT RESOLUTION
11	PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 8, SECTION 5 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF
12	NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE A FIFTY PERCENT PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION
13	FOR ACTIVE EMERGENCY FIRST RESPONDERS OR RETIRED EMERGENCY
14	FIRST RESPONDERS WHO HAVE EARNED AN AMOUNT OF PENSION EQUAL TO
15	ONE HUNDRED PERCENT OF THE RETIREE'S FINAL AVERAGE SALARY AS AN
16	EMERGENCY FIRST RESPONDER IF THE ACTIVE OR RETIRED EMERGENCY
17	FIRST RESPONDER OCCUPIES THE PROPERTY AS THE PERSON'S PRIMARY
18	RESIDENCE.

20	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
21	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 8, Section 5
22	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
23	"A. The legislature shall exempt from taxation the
24	property of each head of the family in the amount of two
25	thousand dollars (\$2,000).

The legislature shall exempt from taxation the 2 property, including the community or joint property of married individuals, of every honorably discharged member of the armed 3 forces of the United States and the [widow or widower] 4 surviving spouse of every such honorably discharged member of 5 the armed forces of the United States, in the sum of: 6 7 (1)in 2006 and in each year through 2023, four thousand dollars (\$4,000); 8 9 (2) in 2024, ten thousand dollars (\$10,000); 10 and in 2025 and each subsequent year, the (3) 11 12 amount provided in Paragraph (2) of this subsection, adjusted for inflation. 13 [C. In every case where exemption is claimed on the 14 ground of the claimant's having served with the armed forces of 15 the United States pursuant to Subsection B of this section, the 16 burden of proving actual and bona fide ownership of such 17 property upon which exemption is claimed shall be upon the 18 19 claimant. 20 C. The legislature shall exempt from taxation fifty percent of the value of property of each certified emergency 21 first responder, as provided by law, who: 22 (1) is active, full-time and certified and has 23 worked as an emergency first responder for at least one year 24 since successfully completing any probationary period required 25 .230019.1 - 2 -

9	residence of the first responder.
10	D. The burden of proving eligibility for an
11	exemption provided by this section is on the person claiming
12	the exemption."
13	SECTION 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution
14	shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
15	rejection at the next general election or at any special
16	election prior to that date that may be called for that
17	purpose.
