



**CYFD – JJS Field FY 23 – Truancy/Absenteeism Referrals**

For FY 23 – JJS Field received a total of **647 Truancy** referrals which were handled **informally** by the JPO office.

The data to the right shows how these referrals were handled and how their completions were categorized.

**PI Decisions with Supervision Outcomes, FY23**

\*\* (blank) indicates no supervision outcome

**Assessed and Referred** – A type of informal handling where the client is referred to services or programming in the local community. The JPO assists with the referral but once it is completed, the case is closed in the JJS system and there is no additional follow up.

**CCA Reject** – This is an outlier referral as current NM law does not allow for truancy or absenteeism referrals to be prosecuted.

**Informal Conditions** – With this type of handling, the JPO will refer the client to services or programming within the community and will keep the case open for monitoring or additional assistance.

**Informal Supervision** – With this type of handling, the JPO will place the client on an informal probation agreement and monitor the client’s progress following the rules of the agreement. It is important to note that this placement is voluntary on the client’s part and failure to comply with the agreement can lead to additional informal action, but the case cannot be referred to the court system if the client violates the terms of the agreement.

**No Further Action (NFA)** – JPO’s will document cases as no further action for several reasons. For Truancy cases, NFA will be documented because the family and the client failed to show for the Preliminary Inquiry or if they decline services. Additionally, JPO’s will document the case as NFA if they are satisfied with the actions taken by the schools or the family prior to the PI and there is no need for additional services.
