HOW ARE WE USING DATA FOR ENROLLMENT/GRADUATION

- NMSU tracks various leading measures that are highly correlated with persistence, retention and graduation. For example, NMSU reviews the D, F, & W rates for the top ten highly enrolled courses each semester to determine if changes in course delivery have a positive impact on course completion.
- NMSU tracks the course success rates for students who receive tutoring services. NMSU tracks the
 number of early alerts submitted by faculty and staff and compare the persistence of those students
 based on the intervention related to the early alert.

WHAT ARE WE DOING DIFFERENTLY TO ENHANCE ENROLLMENT/RETENTION/GRADUATION

- Increase marketing and outreach to target populations the top high schools sending students to NMSU.
- Increased tutoring services for students.
- Offering two different types of summer early start programs to help students review and strengthen their math and English skills before taking their first college course.
- Expanded mental health services to students through additional awareness and education programs and an embedded counselor to special populations.





NMSU Enrollment



Closing the Achievement Gap - 6 Year Graduation Rate




Fall to Fall (1st Year) Retention




Undergraduate Graduate

METRICS

- Enrollment stabilized with outyear goals to increase enrollment to 15,891 by 2027.
- Closing the Achievement Gap: Pell eligible students are often retained and graduate at lower rates than non-Pell eligible students. NMSU is providing success advising, career coaching, and mentoring services specifically for students who need greater levels of support to ensure their success.
- Outyear retention targets basically met with goals to increase retention to 77.5% by 2025.
- Graduation Rates 4-year graduation rate almost doubled between 2014-21 reducing cost of education for students and families and getting them into the workplace faster.
