 - ► Gender: Female 62%; Male 38%

- ► Total adjunct instructors: any given semester 39 to 52
- ► Fall 2021 enrollment headcount: 807

Implications of low salaries

- Teaching overloads/supplementals
- Higher reliance on adjunct faculty
- Recruitment of faculty
- Retention of faculty
 - ► Institutional impact as well as community impact
- Faculty morale and service to the institution and students



Implications of low salaries

- Lack of continuity results in:
 - ► Low student retention and graduation rates
 - ► Lack of innovative course development
 - ► Lack of program development
 - ► Lack of partnership development
 - ► Lack of institutional stability
 - ▶ Difficulty to build institutional reputation
 - ► Limited potential for growth
 - ► Limited potential in professional development
 - ► Lack Shared governance
