ACCOMPLISHMENTS AND GOALS

STATEWIDE INITIATIVES

- State Police Tactical Response Temporary assignment of state police officers to the county of Bernalillo has led to over 93 felony arrests, including individuals with violent criminal histories.
- Cabinet in Your Community Constituent services along with key members of administration and constituent services personnel plan to visit various locations and assist with services from all departments.
- Emergency Assistance Funding Payments were issued to families who were eligible to receive the one-time payment. \$5.6 million distributed to assist 13,000 new Mexico working families.
- Emergency Rental Assistance Program Dashboard created for New Mexicans to apply and check status of applications. Over 24,884 applications approved for assistance and \$59.5 million has been awarded.

 - Program assistance


FY23 Appropriation Request

Overall Costs Comparison by Category FY22/FY23

- Office of the Governor's total request is an increase of 6.3%.
- In the 200s, \$290.0 increase to fund and fill critical positions. Office of the Governor will maintain a slight 1% vacancy rate.
- In the 300s, the request remains flat to the FY 22 operating budget.
- In the 400s, the request remains flat to the FY 22 operating budget.
