



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

Appropriations

The data is from the Capital Project Management System and is self-reported by agencies and local fiscal agents. • CAPITAL OUTLAY UPDATE Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan (ICIP)

- Local infrastructure capital improvement plan (ICIP) establishes planning priorities for anticipated capital projects
- ICIP helps to plan for future capital improvements
- ICIPs must be submitted annually by the deadlines set forth by LGD
- Covers 5 year period and is developed each year (2021-2025)
 - May include the repair/replacement of existing infrastructure or development of new infrastructure
 - Description/Scope of Work, Priority Rank of all projects, Proposed and Secured Funding Budget, Project Budget, Phasing information and Phasing Budget (if applicable), and Operating/Maintenance Budget, Policy Direction, Project Timelines, Estimated Costs, and Justifications
- Entities should update their ICIP based on what was previously funded and programmatic changes that impact their capital needs

• CAPITAL OUTLAY UPDATE Infrastructure Capital Improvement Plan (ICIP)

- The ICIP provides state policymakers with the key information they need to make informed decisions about allocating public funds for local capital improvement projects, construction and renovation of, and equipment for, public structures
- Appropriations made for projects included in an ICIP have a better chance of success because they have been vetted, planned and prioritized for each entity
- Submission of an ICIP by local governments to DFA has gone from less than 50 percent to over 98 percent among political subdivisions in recent years
- However, the formal use of ICIP project information in the state capital appropriations has not been formalized or consistent
- The Local Government Division (LGD) of the Department of Finance and Administration, the lead state agency responsible for administering the local ICIP process, provides statewide training and one-on-one technical assistance on these plans to ensure a consistently high quality document
- Incorporating the use of ICIP data into the capital outlay process, on a formal basis, will:
 - increase chances of success
 - ensure timely completion of each project due to project readiness
 - provide funding sources for functional phases of the project
 - address the most pressing needs identified by each community through a community input process and endorsement by each respective governing body

- Online Capital Outlay Request Form DFA, the Governor's Office, Legislative Counsel Service and LFC are working together to make the capital outlay request online, benefits include:
 - More accessibility and ease of use
 - Data from ICIP can be pulled in if fiscal agent has submitted ICIP
 - Better data collected overall, as fields can be required
 - Ability to cross compare and analyze requests for policy priorities, project readiness, legal issues
