**You can draw and submit Communities of Interest (COIs) or maps or submit comments.**

Respecting **Communities of Interest** (also called neighborhood or regional maps) is a crucial part of fair redistricting that has been discussed since the founding of the nation as a key reason that districts exist. The representative needs to be able to understand the interests of their constituents and communicate those interests to the governing body. A community can be as small as a neighborhood or as large as a whole region. It is any locale needing a voice in government.

**You can submit district maps** for New Mexico U.S. Congress, NM Senate, NM House of Representatives and Public Education Commission. You can even comment on district maps submitted by others.

**You can also submit written testimony.**
