Unlawful possession of a device that converts semiautomatic weapons into fully automatic weapons by a person consists of a person knowingly having a device that converts semiautomatic weapons into fully automatic weapons in the person's possession or knowingly transporting a device that converts semiautomatic weapons into fully automatic weapons. |
| 16 17 | B. Prosecution pursuant to this section shall not prevent prosecution pursuant to any other provision of the law when the conduct also constitutes a violation of that other provision. |
| 18 19 | C. Each device found in violation of this section constitutes a separate offense under Subsection A. |
| 20 21 | D. A person who commits unlawful possession of a device that converts semiautomatic weapons into fully automatic weapons is guilty of a third-degree felony. |

| 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 | (1) The term "device" includes: a. A part designed and intended for use in converting a semiautomatic weapon into a fully automatic weapon; b. A combination of parts designed and intended for use in converting a semiautomatic weapon into a fully automatic weapon; or c. Any combination of parts from which a fully automatic weapon can be assembled if such parts are in the possession or under the control of a person. |

- (2) "Convert" means cause to change in form, character, or function to a firearm.
- (3) "Semiautomatic weapon" means any repeating rifle, shotgun or pistol, regardless of barrel or overall length, which utilizes a portion of the energy of a firing cartridge or shell to extract the fired cartridge case or spent shell and chamber the next round, and which requires a separate pull of the trigger to fire each cartridge or shell.
 - (4) "Fully automatic weapon" means a weapon that:
 - a. shoots;
 - b. is designed to shoot; or
 - c. can be readily restored to shoot automatically more than one (1) shot, without manual reloading, by a single function of the trigger.
