

## Silver City's Workforce Housing Project: Vistas de Plata Subdivision



- Affordable Housing Plan adopted in January 2011
- Subdivision established in 2011
- Modular houses ranging from 1100-1800 sqft
- Currently accepting applicants who do not exceed 120% of AMI
- Phase 1a & 1b completed, with lots available for installation in lb.

56 Lots Total

The subdivision has water and sewer, pavement, curbs, gutters, and sidewalks.

Phases 2, 3, and 4 are still in need of funds for grading, drainage, and conduit:


Phase 2- \$1,488,000


