Navajo DOT Services

- Federally Funded Annually
 - Administration Overhead Cost/Equipment/Operation
- Tribal Transportation Improvement Project, Navajo Nation
- Federal Highway Funds, US Transportation
- Tribal Funds, Navajo Nation, Tribal Council Legislation

- Navajo Nation 110 Chapters - 9,500 dirt/unpaved roads
- New Mexico - 4,500 dirt/unpaved roads
- Navajo DOT – 15 Miles of Regional Routes for Chapters of 110





Jurisdictional Issues

- Bureau of Indian Affairs
- County
- State
- Private
- Checkerboard
- Bureau of Land Management



Partnership

- BIA – may request assistance of Navajo DOT through Chapter Resolution – 15 Mile Regional Route
- County – may request assistance of Navajo DOT through IGA or MOU
- State – may request assistance of Navajo DOT through IGA or MOU



New Mexico State Highway

- 491 – NM State Highway
- 371 – NM State Highway
- Right of Way of 491 and 371 are under NM State Highway
- Navajo Nation Lands Status, county, or BIA may be located beyond State ROW



Dust Storm Control through Navajo Division of Natural Resources

- NDONR – Grazing Officials
 - Permit of livestock grazing areas
 - Livestock Reduction / Tally Count
 - Plans of seeding of land
 - Plans of Erosion Control
 - Plans of Land Diversion
 - Plans on Land Management
